### **Short title**

BA (Hons) Languages and International Engagement.

### **Award letters**

BA (Hons) Lang & Int Eng (Open)

### **Entry requirements**

This qualification is only available to students who have completed Ministry of Defence (MoD) Defence Centre for Languages and Culture courses / exams at standard language profile (SLP) level 2 and/or Level 3 in any language except English.

### **Maximum duration of study**

16 years, see additional rules section.

### **Credit requirement**

360 credits.

### **Stage 1 (120 credits)**

International Engagement and English: 120 credits from compulsory modules to include a minimum of 60 credits of credit transfer.

International Engagement and French/German/Spanish: 60 credits from a compulsory module, 30 credits from core modules and 30 credits from a

further compulsory module, to include a minimum of 60 credits of credit transfer.

### **Stage 2 (120 credits)**

60 credits from specified compulsory modules and 60 credits from core option modules

### **Stage 3 (120 credits)**

International Engagement and English: 60 credits from a compulsory module and 60 credits from core option modules

International Engagement and French/German/Spanish: 120 credits from specified compulsory modules

### **Maximum transferred credit**

240 credits

### **Maximum age of credit transfer**

5 years

### **Unique study requirement**

120 credits at OU Stage 3

### **Additional rules**

All students require credit transfer of at least 60-credits at Level 1 derived from prior languages study through the MOD. Credit transfer awards reduce the maximum duration of study as set out in the Academic Regulations.
