BSc (Hons) Nursing

- 4-year part-time nursing programme
- Blend of online and practice-based learning

What do I need to apply?

- Numeracy & Literacy at SCQF level 5 or equivalent
- Hold a permanent post in a partner Health Board/Employer in Scotland and have your line manager's support
- Be able to work 26+ hours per week whilst on clinical placement*
- Have 10 years in full time education including school years
- Hold EU Settlement or Indefinite Leave to Remain status and have access to public funds

**some boards/employers may require you to work full time hours on clinical placement*
